Col. (Doctor) Todd W. Poindexter is the Chief of Clinical Operations for the Air Force Medical Support Agency. Dr. Poindexter is responsible for developing clinical policy for the entire Air Force Medical Service. Col. Poindexter graduated from Eastern Mennonite University in May 1987 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Biology. He was awarded a Medical Doctorate degree from Medical College of Virginia in 1993 and was commissioned a Captain in the U.S. Air Force under the Health Professions Scholarship Program in June 1993.

He completed a residency in Family Practice at Malcolm Grow Medical Center, Andrews Air Force Base, Maryland in 1996. Following residency, in July 1996, he was assigned to the 39th Medical Group at Incirlik Air Base, Turkey and then went to the 52nd Medical Group at Bitburg Air Base, Germany in July 1999. During this assignment he served as the Flight Commander, Medical Services Flight. In August 2002, Dr. Poindexter was assigned to the 97th Medical Group as the Chief of the Medical Staff. In July 2006, he was reassigned to the 4th Medical Group, Seymour Johnson AFB, NC where he also served as the Chief of the Medical Staff. He assumed his current position at the Air Force Medical Support Agency in July 2010. He is board certified in the specialty of Family Medicine and a Diplomat of the American Board of Family Practice. Col. Poindexter is married to Maha A. Poindexter. They are the proud parents of Lina Poindexter (16), Lydia Poindexter (14) and Daniel Poindexter (12).
