RANDY G. TILLERY

Mr. Randy G. Tillery is the Director of Airman and Family Care, Air Force Personnel Center, Randolph Air Force Base, Texas. The Airman and Family Care Directorate includes five Divisions with over 190 military, civilians, and contractors assigned working a diverse portfolio of programs. The Divisions include: Air Reserve Component Case Management, Casualty Matters, Disability, Airman and Family, and Warrior and Survivor Care. The major programs include Medical Continuation, Airman and Family Readiness, Resilience, Air Force Families Forever, Retiree Services, Survivor Benefit Program, Wounded, Ill, and Injured Non-Medical Care Management, Recovery Care Coordination, and Adaptive Sports, Informal and Formal Physical Evaluation Boards, Temporary Duty Retirement List, Combat Related Special Compensation, Casualty, and Missing Persons.

Mr. Tillery served 30 years as an active duty Air Force Officer.
