Ms. Nancy B. Adams serves the Warrior Transition Command as the Branch Chief for the Career and Education Readiness Branch. Prior to working for the Army Warrior Transition Command Ms. Adams worked as the Branch Chief, Military Training for the Defense Contract Management Agency in Springfield, Virginia from 2005-2010. In this joint assignment she coordinated acquisition training and professional military education for all military personnel assigned to DCMA.

Ms. Adams has served as an Army Education Services Specialist at Fort Belvoir, VA; Ft. Myer, VA; and at Patton Barracks, Heidelberg, Germany. She also managed the Army Career and Alumni Program offices in Heidelberg and Mannheim, Germany from 1999-2000.

Ms. Adams has held counseling positions at San Diego State University, San Diego Community College, Northern Virginia Community College and the Arlington Employment Center in Arlington, VA.

Her degrees include a Bachelor of Arts in European History from the University of Virginia, and a Master of Science degree in Vocational Rehabilitation Counseling from San Diego State University. Ms. Adams is a graduate of the USDA Executive Potential Program for senior level federal employees, and a recipient of the Exceptional Civilian Service Award and Commander's Award for Civilian Service for her work with Wounded Warriors.
